5. Departmental Meeting Recap

- Recently the meeting has been only faculty, but now Laurel Schafer wants a CGSS representative to attend
 - i. We need a permanent person to attend the meeting, Carina agreed to do this
 - ii. Nealan attended the October departmental meeting as a one-time thing
- New professor being interviewed
- Adding a Masters tuition award
- UBC projected to go into a little bit of a financial deficit and worsen next year
 - i. Chemistry department should be fine
- There is going to be a cap on incoming international graduate students (not sure when)
- The department is slowly increasing our GRA stipend
- Grad student focused initiatives
 - i. Pls must fil out annual student progress reports/assessment
- New money for summer grad student stipends that work for an assistant professor
- The department wants to transition away from semester-long 3 credit system
 - i. Introduce 1-credit 1-month long modules
- Graduate Matters: we have 42 new grad students, everyone with pre-arranged PIs, 11 with scholarships
 - i. New: Master defenses are going to be chaired by teaching/lecture professors instead of emeritus faculty
 - ii. New: PhD defense chairs will be chaired by the department-pick if we can't get emeritus faculty
 - We will let Laurel know our opinions
- Going to be a new department website

6. Meeting with the Chemistry Head

- President (and/or treasurer) has monthly meetings with Laurel Schafer
- More awards (12) will be available next summer
 - i. We are asked to think about the criteria
 - ii. Asked that we use all our donations to CGSS awards/endowment instead
 - Currently we split between charity and awards
 - We should double check where our money is going
